

COMPREHENSIVE HEALTHCARE SYSTEM

Our university is proud to offer a unique and diverse range of medical facilities to our students and staff. We have built an Ayurvedic hospital, an Allopathic hospital, and a Homeopathic Hospital, all of which are equipped with state-of-the-art technology and staffed by highly trained medical professionals. In addition, we have an advanced operation theatre and high-end X-ray machine, allowing us to provide a comprehensive range of medical options to our community. We operate a mobile clinic to provide healthcare services to students and staff, as well as nearby communities.

Our university has established partnerships with numerous healthcare facilities to provide students with comprehensive clinical training and practical experience. We have signed Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with hospitals, established a satellite health center, and have tie-ups with Primary Health Centers (PHCs) and Community Health Centers (CHCs). These partnerships enable our students to gain hands-on experience in a variety of clinical settings, under the supervision of experienced healthcare professionals. For medical emergencies, we have a fleet of ambulances on standby.

PROVIDE ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE HEALTHCARE

Our institution is committed to the safety and well-being of both our employees and students. To ensure their protection in case of unforeseen events, we provide comprehensive accidental health insurance coverage to our employees as well as our students, providing them with much-needed financial security in the event of an unexpected accident or fatality.

University ensures accessibility to quality healthcare for all teaching, non-teaching staff, and even supporting staff like housekeeping, drivers, and canteen staff and community, by offering free services, the university tackles financial barriers to healthcare access. Due to the importance of preventative healthcare in the context of holistic wellness, the University's facilities offer free health checks and thalassemia testing for all students. This proactive strategy empowers students to manage their health and detect risks.

HEALTH EDUCATION AND AWARENESS PROGRAMS

Schools of Nursing, Physiotherapy, Homeopathy and Ayurveda organize weekly health camps in nearby villages to provide medical check-ups, health education, and awareness programs for the community.

To promote health awareness, the university actively celebrates numerous health days throughout the year, including World Heart Day, World Mental Health Day, World Cancer Day, World Diabetes Day etc. In addition, students from diverse disciplines such as Nursing, Physiotherapy, Homeopathy are also assigned to hospitals in accordance with regulatory organizations to guarantee ample exposure to holistic care for these students.

FACILITATE HEALTHY LIFESTYLE

University promotes healthy habits in staff and students through nutrition and fitness workshops, and provides access to recreational facilities, fitness classes, Yoga sessions, Zumba sessions, weekly sports sessions and month end celebrations.

The university boasts a cutting-edge gymnasium facility that is separated by gender. In addition, the university promotes physical activity and a healthy lifestyle by encouraging students to take the stairs instead of the elevator. The university recognizes the importance of mental well-being. A team of qualified counsellors and psychologists provides individual and group therapy sessions

HEALTHCARE INITIATIVE DURING PANDEMIC COVID-19

P P Savani University has collaborated with local government and health officials to organize periodic COVID-19 testing camps on campus. Additionally, we coordinated immunization drives for the staff, faculty, students and nearby industries persons. We distributed covid-19 preventive medicine recommended by AYUSH department and food parcels were also distributed to truck drivers, individuals and families impacted by unemployment and financial difficulties resulting from the pandemic.

When the pandemic hit, our institution made sure to protect our employees by providing COVID-19 insurance coverage to all staff. Unfortunately, a few members of our team were affected by the virus and were able to use the insurance to pay for their medical expenses, which would have otherwise been a significant financial burden. Our students and staff have devised innovative measures to combat the transmission of COVID-19. These include the development of masks coated with nano-materials, the creation of an organic sanitizer, and the invention of a contactless sanitizer dispenser machine. The university extended both emotional and financial assistance to students who lost their parents as a result of the pandemic, in the form of waived fees and scholarships.

EVIDENCEOF SUCCESS

Our commitment to healthcare excellence is reflected in our state-of-the-art facilities, including a hundred-bed Ayurvedic hospital, a twenty five-bed Allopathic hospital, and a twenty five -bed Homeopathic hospital, offering a range of effective treatment options for our patients. Traditional Panchakarma treatment is available at the Ayurvedic Hospital with all the necessary equipment. Both traditional practices and cutting-edge medical technology are utilized at the Homeopathic Hospital.

We have signed Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with seventeen hospitals and have tie-ups with seven Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and Community Health Centers (CHCs). Our university's Satellite Health Centre at Kosamba provides quality healthcare services to the surrounding communities, with a focus on accessible and affordable care

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS

In the last five years, our university has conducted an impressive two hundred plus health activities for community development, demonstrating our commitment to improving health and well-being. Regular Health Day celebrations and awareness initiatives are part of our university's commitment to improving health and well-being. We host frequent Thalassemia campaigns, blood donation drives, and stem cell donation drives because we aim to educate our community about different health conditions.

The university provides a Health Insurance Reimbursement policy to promote the health and well-being of its employees, offering financial aid for medical costs. During the current year, over hundred employees have availed the benefits of this policy, resulting in the university reimbursing healthcare expenses exceeding twelve lakhs. Furthermore, we have revised our leave policy to provide increased adaptability and provisions for the overall welfare of our employees.

EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS

In line with the Fit India movement, our University Sports department works to make sure that staff members are physically healthy. We plan fun games and exercise sessions outside every week. These activities not only help our staff stay fit, but they also bring them together and urge them to live a healthy life.

Department of Public Health participated in a community mental health project in 2021 organized by UHCRCE, Surat and the department got project grant for community mental health program.

The PPSU vaccination centre has administered over two thousand doses of the Covid vaccine to individuals. The students and staff have demonstrated remarkable creativity and resourcefulness in creating Nanocoated masks, organic sanitizers and contact less sanitizer dispenser, and we are pleased to witness their diligent efforts and commitment making a beneficial contribution in the battle against COVID-19. More than two thousand bottles of organic sanitizer and nearly five thousand masks were distributed by university during pandemic.

Members of Faculty and students of the university diligently published a significant amount of data during the Covid Pandemic. Five research articles and one review paper were published in reputable journals.

The information comprised several research articles on various Covid-related topics, such as "Polymorphic landscape of SARS-CoV-2 genomes isolated from the Indian population in 2020 demonstrates rapid evolution in ORF3a, ORF8, nucleocapsid phosphorylation, and spike glycoprotein"; "In Silico Docking Studies of Antimalarial Drug Hydroxychloroquine to SARS-CoV Proteins: An Emerging Pandemic Worldwide"; Impact of COVID-19 Pandemic on Mental Health and Effects of a Sense of Verdict of Selected College Students in Nepal, Nigeria and India" etc.



1. Introduction

The outbreak of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) was reported from Wuhan, China on 31 December 2019 and by March 11, 2020, it was declared as a global pandemic. The COVID-19 is caused by a novel human pathogen which was initially named 2019-a0vel coronavirus (2019-n0CV) and later officially named Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2 (SARS-COV-2) by the Coronaviridae Study Group (CSG) of the International Committee on Taxonomy of Viruses (Gorbaevar et al., 2020). The complete genome of the SARS-COV-2 was first obtained and submitted by Wang et al. (2020). Phylogenetic analysis of the submitted sequence revealed 89.1% nucleotide similarity between the SARS-COV-2 and SARS-like coronaviruus (genus Betaconomavirus, subgenus Sarbecovirus) previously found in bats (Hu et al., 2018), indicating viral spill-over from animals to humans (Wu et al., 2020).

The genome of SARS-CoV-2 includes an orderly arrangement of 5'untranslated region (UTR), replicase complex (ORF1ab), spike glycoprotein, ORF3a, envelope, membrane glycoprotein, ORF6, ORF7a, ORITH, ORFR, nucleocapsid phosphoprotein, ORFIO, and 3'-UTR (Jungreis et al., 2021; Winng et al., 2020). The ORFI ab refers to the two ORFS, ORFI a and ORFID, combined via programmed -1 frameshift four codons before the end of ORFIa. ORFI ta and Ib are broadly responsible for control of genome expression and viral replication, respectively (Jungreis et al., 2021). The SARS-CoV-2 is an enveloped virus, which belongs to the family of coronaviruses and carries - 30 kb positive-sense single-stranded RNA as its genetic material (Laamarti et al., 2020). REMDESIVIR: NEW HOPE FROM EBOLA VIRUS TO COVID-19

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ABSTRACT

Nations around the world are presently fighting the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, which is caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). Currently, COVID-19 does not have a recognized antiviral treatment. Various clinical hearings have been originated to recognize a working treatment. One important contender is remdesivir (GS-5734), a broad- spectrum antiviral that was firstly industrialized for the treatment of Ebola virus (EBOV). A variety of studies have been conducted since the outbreak of Coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) in order to describe and find the best way to combat Coronavirus disease 2 (SARS-CoV-2). The antiviral drug, remdesivir (GS-5734), previously tested against the Ebola virus was moderately effective and probably safe in inhibiting the replication of the SARS-CoV-2 virus after numerous suggestions and assessments. During the week of 1 May 2020, the Food and Drug Administration approved remdesivir (GS-5734) as an investigational drug for the treatment of Covid-19.

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INTRODUCTION

In 2016, when it was first developed to battle the Ebola virus disease(EVD) outburst in Africa, the story of remdesivir started with the enlargement code name of GS-5734 (Warren TK, 2016). The nucleoside analog (NA) remdesivir inhibits the RNA-dependent RNA polymerase (RdRp). The active form of remdesivir (GS-441524), inhibits viral RNA polymerase, restricting viral duplication, after metabolism into its active form (Agostini Maria L, 2018). Coronaviruses (CoV) are participants of the family Coronaviruses (CoV) are redictively and contain a huge number of enclosed, positive-sense single-stranded RNA viruses causing a variety of infections in animals and humans (J. 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Impact of COVID-19 Pandemic on Mental Health and Effects of a Sense of Verdict of Selected College Students in Nepal, Nigeria and India

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Abstract

Background: The COVID-19 pandemic has brought a negative impact on mental health among college students across the world. Mental health issues are the leading obstacle to academic success. Aim of the study was to assess the prevalence and impact of COVID-19 on mental health and effects of a sense of verdict of selected college students from Nepal, Nigeria and India.

Methods: Non-probability, snowball sampling technique was applied for data collection. A total of 696 responses were recorded from selected colleges from Nepal, Nigeria and India. Online survey-based platform was used to distribute the e-questionnaire to collect the information. Online survey was conducted from 15th to 30th June 2020.

Results: More than half of the respondents 390(56%) had experienced depression during lockdown period. Majority of respondents 45(75.0%) from Nigeria had undergone depression followed by Nepal 73(58.87%) and India 271(52.93%). Young respondents 194(38.6%) in the age group of 18-20 years had experienced mild depression.

Conclusion: The lockdown due to COVID-19 pandemic has been brought an extraordinary academic challenge to the students across the world. It is necessary to adapt holistic approach to develop interventions and preventive strategies to address the mental health of college students for their well being.
