

## 100 POINT ACTIVITY CONTRIBUTION

#### 1. Preamble

To cultivate and encourage versatility among the budding technocrats, P P Savani School of Engineering is introducing '100 Point Activity'. Under this scheme, students will be awarded 10 points for executing co-curricular and extra-curricular activities on and outside of the campus. A student enrolled in P P Savani School of Engineering, must earn a minimum of 100 points during the four years of academics by performing activities prescribed in the 'List of Activities'. It is a mandatory additional requirement for earning B. Tech. Degree.

### 2. Objective(s)

The objectives of the '100 Point Activity' are to:

- make socially responsible technocrats.
- ensure holistic development of the students.
- cultivate benevolence and altruism in the students.
- encourage innovation & creativity.
- · provide a platform for leadership and teamwork.
- · boost and reward co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

# 3. To whom it applies?

An undergraduate Engineering student must earn the following minimum activity points as per the level of Entry in the B. Tech. program as shown in Table I.

Level of Entry in B. Tech	Total Years for Points	Minimum Points
1st Year Regular	1st to 4th Year	100
2 <sup>nd</sup> Year Regular or D2D or Transfer from other university from the academic year 2021-22	2 <sup>nd</sup> to 4 <sup>th</sup> Year	50

#### 4. Student's Role

- Every student shall participate in the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities as prescribed in the 'List of Activities' point.
- Students have to produce a documentary proof for the executed activity to the designated class coordinator.
- It is mandatory to prepare a file containing documentary proofs of activities done by him/her.
- A brief presentation to be prepared for activities carried out during the semester.





#### 5. Evaluation Scheme

- The file and presentation of the activity will be duly verified by the respective class coordinator & invited experts if need be.
- The class coordinator will enter the points as per the 'List of Activity'.
- The points earned will not be a part of SGPA/CGPA calculations.
- Failing to earn prescribed points will lead to withhold the degree certificate.
- Each activity carries 10 points. Points will be rewarded only one time for each activity.
- It is mandatory to provide proof for the executed activity.

#### 6. List of Activities

To earn points, a student can choose any of the following activities:

#### **Category: Education**

- 1. A student need to teach underprivileged students for minimum 10 hours. The activity can be either independent or in affiliation with NGO working for society welfare. The class coordinator must be informed about the same in starting of the activity. To submit a proof for the activity, a student can ask the NGO to provide certificate or hour wise teaching points and Photos should be submitted to class coordinator.
- 2. A student contributing special coaching for minimum 10 hours in the under privileged school will be considered for earning 10 points on submission of certificate from the school principal along with photographs.

#### **Category: Social Contribution**

- 1. A student sparing minimum 10 hours at Old Age Home or Orphanage Home to execute activities like sports, entertainment, cultural, religious, counselling, spreading awareness for literacy, skills, hygiene etc. However, providing financial aid will not reward the points. To submit a proof for the activity, a student can ask the organization to provide certificate or photos of the executed activities shall be submitted to class coordinator.
- 2. A student need to donate blood at least Four Times during the graduation period at PPSU. The blood donation certificate/card along with relevant photos should be submitted to class coordinator to earn the points.
- 3. A student can run a campaign 'Joy of Giving' under which, his/her responsibility will be to collect used clothes, blankets or any other useful things and distribute them to underprivileged people. At the end of two such activities, detailed report with photograph shall be submitted to the respective class coordinator. Not more than Five Students will be considered for points for one activity within campus/outside campus.
- 4. Planting and cultivating a tree at least till 4 feet height growth within or outside of the university. The place for tree plantation shall be informed to the class coordinator. Name plate



- should be given to the plant and photos of growing tree must be shared with the class coordinator on quarterly basis.
- 5. A public place required to clean shall be identified and cleaned. Prior permission of the respective authority shall be taken if needed. 'After, while and before the activity' photos shall be taken and submitted to the class coordinator. Not more than Five Students will be considered for points for one activity within campus/outside campus.

# Category: Skill Building/Upgradation/Transfer Student can score 10 points by:

- 1. Female students undertaking self-defense training for minimum 10 hours & upon submission of certificate & photograph.
- 2. Undertaking self-development course related to grooming, personality development, soft skills, domain relevant, music/art related for minimum 10 hours & upon submission of certificate & photograph.
- 3. Being invited as an expert/speaker for curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular activity, & upon submission of certificate/letter/photograph.
- 4. Working as an Editorial Member for book, Newsletter, Journal or author of a book & upon submission of the copy of letter/certificate of services extended.
- 5. Participating or being member in organizing committee in national/international level offline Short Term Training Program (STTP), seminar, and conferences & upon submission of certificate/letter of Chief Coordinator.
- 6. Being first author in poster presentation/ research paper presentation/publication & upon submission of Poster/research paper.
- 7. Filing/publishing patent and submission of the relevant certificate.
- 8. Implementing innovative solution for solving real time social/University problem.
- 9. Being awarded start-up funding under SSIP of P P Savani University.

# Category:Sports/Cultural

# Student can score 10 points by:

- 1. Being Winner or runner up at district level sport event organized by district authority & upon submission of the certificate.
- 2. Representing PPSU at District team for sport event organized by state authorities & upon submission of the certificate.
- 3. Winning Inter College Tournament & upon submission of the certificate.
- 4. Representing P P Savani University Team at Inter-University Tournament and securing entry in quarter final level or higher & upon submission of the certificate.
- 5. Securing Winner or Runner up position at district/state/national level cultural event organized by respective authority & upon submission of the certificate.





- 6. Representing P P Savani University at district/state/national level or participating in intercollegiate competition for cultural event organized by the respective authorities and securing position at least in quarter final round or higher & upon submission of the certificate.
- 7. Being winner of University level cultural/technical/sport event & upon submission of the certificate.
- 8. Organizing cultural/sport/technical event at university level as core committee members & upon submission of letter from Sports/Cultural Coordinator of the University. In one event only 10 students will be awarded points.
- 9. Undertaking a certified course in yoga & meditation & upon submission of the certificate.
- 10. By attending one residential camp of National Service Scheme (NSS) & upon submission of the certificate.
