

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY FINANCIAL NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

Term & Conditions:

- > Students must pass every semester examination on the first attempt, maintain regular attendance, display disciplined and exemplary behavior, and comply with all other norms prescribed by the University from time to time.
- A student may lose their scholarship starting from the next semester/year if they fail to satisfy any of the specified criteria. In such cases, there will be no replacement for the scholarship for the entire duration of the program. A student who fails to qualify for the scholarship in any semester/year during the program will not be entitled to the award of the scholarship thereafter.
- > The scholarship may be withdrawn at any stage if the information furnished is found to be false and/or if it is later discovered that the student was involved in an untoward incident inside or outside the campus at any time during their stay at the University.
- > Students need to apply every year for continuing the scholarship.
- > Students needs to inform if their financial status changes.

Documents Required:

- > Self-attested copy of 12th (HSC) mark sheet along with Certificate for applicants of Science, Engineering, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Interior Design Department.
- > Self-attested copy of 12th (HSC) and NATA Mark sheets along with Certificate for applicants from Architect Department.
- > Self-attested copy of Admission slip issued by ACPC for engineering students and ACPUGMEC for Physiotherapy and Nursing students.
- > Self-attested copy of Admission Slips issued by University for science and interior design department.



- > Self-attested copy of PAN Card & ADHAAR CARD of Father, Mother and Candidate.
- > Self-attested copy of bank Statement of mother and father.
- > Self-attested copy of Income proof. (IT return, Salary certificate, Government income certificate)
- Letter of recommendation from the last attended school to avail benefits of scholarship.

Procedure:

- The Applicant needs to fill up the scholarship form as per the given guidelines.
- > Scholarship forms will be available with administrative department.
- > Produce the required documents as per the guidelines.
- Successful applicants shall be duly informed.

The above policy-procedure is subject to modification whenever found necessary by the University. The Scholarship Committee shall have the final authority to grant the scholarship and shall not be liable to give any justification.

MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP

P. P. Savani University's Merit based Scholarship will be granted to those talented students who are extraordinary performer in their academics. The University offers this scholarship to motivate the meritorious students and to achieve further excellence in their academics. The applicants shall be required to adhere given criteria and guidelines to avail benefits of this scholarship.





Guidelines to avail Scholarship:

- > The scholarship committee, keeping in view relative merits, will decide award of scholarship to top meritorious students in each discipline outlined below.
- > It is compulsory for students to fill the scholarship form.
- > From 1st year onwards their CGPA will get considered for further extension.
- > In case students get detained, student needs to submit all the gained scholarship back to the university without clearance of scholarship he/she will not be eligible for re-enrollment.
- ➤ In case student left the institute, he/she needs to submit all the gained scholarship back to the university. Without clearance of scholarship his/her admission will not considered as cancelled.

Eligibility Criteria:

- > Topper students from their respective branch as per given criteria can apply to avail benefits of this scholarship.
- > In case of other state board applicants, who don't satisfy below mentioned merit criteria, committee will look
 - after their eligibility from their 12th (HSC) results but for that they have to apply for the scholarship.

Terms and Conditions:

- A student is liable to lose his/her scholarship from the next Semester/year if he/she fails to satisfy any of the specified criteria, in such case/s there shall not be any replacement of the student/s for the scholarship during the entire duration of the program. A student failing to qualify for the scholarship in any semester/year during the program shall not be entitled for the award of Scholarship thereafter.
- Scholarship will be withdrawn at any stage, if the information furnished are found to be false and/or it is found at a later date that the student was involved in untoward incident inside/outside the campus at any time during his/her stay at the University.
- > Students needs to apply every time on year-to-year basis for continuing the scholarship.

- > Self-attested copy of 12th (HSC) marksheets along with Certificate for applicants of Science, Engineering, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Interior Design Department.
- > Self-attested copy of 12th (HSC) and NATA Marksheets along with Certificate for applicants from Architect Department.
- > Self-attested copy of Admission slip issued by admission allotting body like ACPC, ACPUGMEC etc.
- > Self-attested copy of Admission Slips issued by University.
- > Self-attested copy of Fees Receipt issued by University.

For Students 1st year Onwards:

- > Self-attested copy of their all semester marksheets.
- > Self-attested copy of Fees Receipt issued by University.
