The cause of the disease is a tiny bacillus, some 0.004 millimeter long at the most, which was first discovered by the German bacteriologist Robert Koch in 1882. As well as the bacillus which specifically infects human beings, there is a type which infects cattle but may also attack humans, there are also different strains which cause TB in birds, mice and other animals.
