

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Admission Requirements

B. Sc. Nursing

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- GUJCET Examination certificate is necessary.
- Minimum education: 10+2 class passed with Science (PCB) & English Core/English Elective with aggregate of 45% marks from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board.
- Student shall be medically fit.
- Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks. 5% is relaxed for SC/ST candidates.

Entrance/ selection test

Selection of the candidates shall take place as per regulation of the University and Govt of Gujarat.

Duration

- Duration of the course shall be four years including internship
- Week available per year- 52 Weeks

Academic Rules & Regulations

1. Important Terms

- a. Academic year: two consecutive (one odd+ one even) semester constitute one academic year.
- b. Semester: each semester will consist of 15-18 weeks of academic work equivalent to 90 actual teaching days. The odd semester may be scheduled from October to March and even semester from April to September.
- c. Programme: An educational programme leading to award of a degree, diploma or certificate.
- d. Courses: usually referred to, as "Paper /Subject" is a component of programme. All courses need not carry the same weight. A course may be designed to comprise lectures/ tutorials/ laboratories/ work/ field work/ out-reach activities/ project work/ vocational training/ viva/ seminars/ term papers/ assignments/ self-study etc. or a combination of some of these. The courses should define learning objectives and learning outcomes and pre- requisite if any.
- e. Choice- based credit system- the CBCS provides choice for students to select from the described courses (foundation, core, elective or skilled courses). Choice- based semester system will be followed across P P Savani University both at under-graduate and post graduate levels. Each enrolled student will be required to take a minimum specified load of course work in the chosen subject of specialization and also complete a project / dissertation if any. Once registered at the start of semester, no student will be allowed to withdraw at any point of time, during the semester. (NOT APPLICABLE FOR SCHOOL OF NURSING)
- f. Credit based semester system (CBSS) Under the CBSS, the requirement for awarding a degree or diploma or certificate is prescribed in terms of number of credits to be completed by the student. (NOT APPLICABLE FOR SCHOOL OF NURSING)
- g. Credit- A unit by which a course work is measured. It determines the number of hours of instructions required per week. One credit is equivalent to one hour of teaching(lecture of tutorial) or two hours of practical work / field work per week in general, 1 credit is equivalent to 15 hours of teaching (lecture or tutorial) or 30 hour of practical work / field work.
- h. Letter Grade- it is a index of the performance of students in a said course. Grades are denoted by letters O, A+, A, B+, B, C, P and F.
- i. Grade Point: It is a numerical weight allotted to each letter grade on a 10-point scale.
- j. Credit Point: It is the product of grade point and number of credits for a course.
- k. Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA): It is a measure of performance of work done in a semester. It is ratio of total credit points secured by a student in various courses registered in a semester and the total course credits taken during that semester. It shall be expressed up to two decimal places.
- 1. Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA): It is a measure of overall cumulative performance of a student over all semesters. The CGPA is the ratio of total credit points secured by a student in various courses in all semesters and the sum of the total credits of all courses in all the semesters. It is expressed up to two decimal places.
- m. Transcript or Grade Card or Certificate: Based on the grades earned, a grade certificate shall be issued to all the registered students after every semester. The grade certificate will display the course details (code, title, number of credits, grade secured) along with SGPA of that semester and CGPA earned till that semester.



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2. Admissions

Admission under various courses will be done as per prescribed guidelines of the Government of Gujarat and P P Savani University.

3. Programme Duration

4. Course Evaluation

All Courses/Subjects offered at P P Savani University shall be evaluated under two heads:

- a. Continuous Evaluation (CE) component which is under sole discretion of the course coordinator. It is expected that the continuous evaluation should consist of Unit Test/Weekly Test/Fortnightly Test/Class Test/Presentations/Project Work/Assignment/Group Discussion/Quiz/Seminar/Debate etc. The maximum mark of Continuous Evaluation (CE) component is 25 percent. The marks of CE component should be submitted by course coordinator to University Exam Section in the format prescribed by the University.
- b. End Semester Examination, conducted by University through written paper or practical test or oral test or presentation by the student or a combination of any one, two or more of these. The maximum mark of End Semester Examination is 75 percent.
- c. The End Semester Examination will be evaluated by appointing two subject experts, one from outside University and another from within University, for all courses offered under University.
- d. The total of the Continuous Evaluation Component and End Semester Examination marks in each course will be converted to a letter grade on a ten-point scale as per the following scheme:

- e. In order to earn the credit in a course a student has to obtain grade other than F.
- f. A student, who obtains (less than 50 % marks) has to repeat the university examination till he/she obtains grade B.
- g. No student is allowed to upgrade the grade.
- h. The student's performance in any semester will be assessed by the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA). Similarly, his/her performance at the end of two or more consecutive semesters will be denoted by the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). The SGPA and CGPA are calculated as per guidelines of UGC.
- i. In a semester, the SGPA is the ratio of sum of the product of the number of credits with the grade points scored by a student in all the courses taken by a student and the sum of the number of credits of all the courses undergone by a student, i.e. SGPA (Si) = Σ (Ci x Gi) / Σ Ci Where, Ci is the number of credits of the ith course and Gi is the grade point scored by the student in the ith course.
- j. The CGPA is also calculated in the same manner taking into account all the courses undergone by a student over all the semesters of a programme, i.e. $CGPA = \Sigma(Ci \ge Si) / \Sigma Ci$ Where, Si is the SGPA of the ith semester and Ci is the total number of credits in that semester.
- k. The SGPA and CGPA shall be rounded off to 2 decimal points and reported in the grade-card& transcript.

5. Attendance

a. Attendance is compulsory in all subjects. The minimum attendance under each course is 80% (Theory and Practical). Any student failing to fulfill attendance requirements, will not be allowed to appear for University Examination unless and until medical certificate is produced.



6. Promotion Rules

- a. All the students of odd semester are allowed to move to even semester irrespective of their results.
- b. At the end of a year, a student is not allowed to move to odd semester in case of his/her CGPA is less than 3.00.
- c. Over and above, the school has to follow the guidelines laid down by the statutory body time to time.
